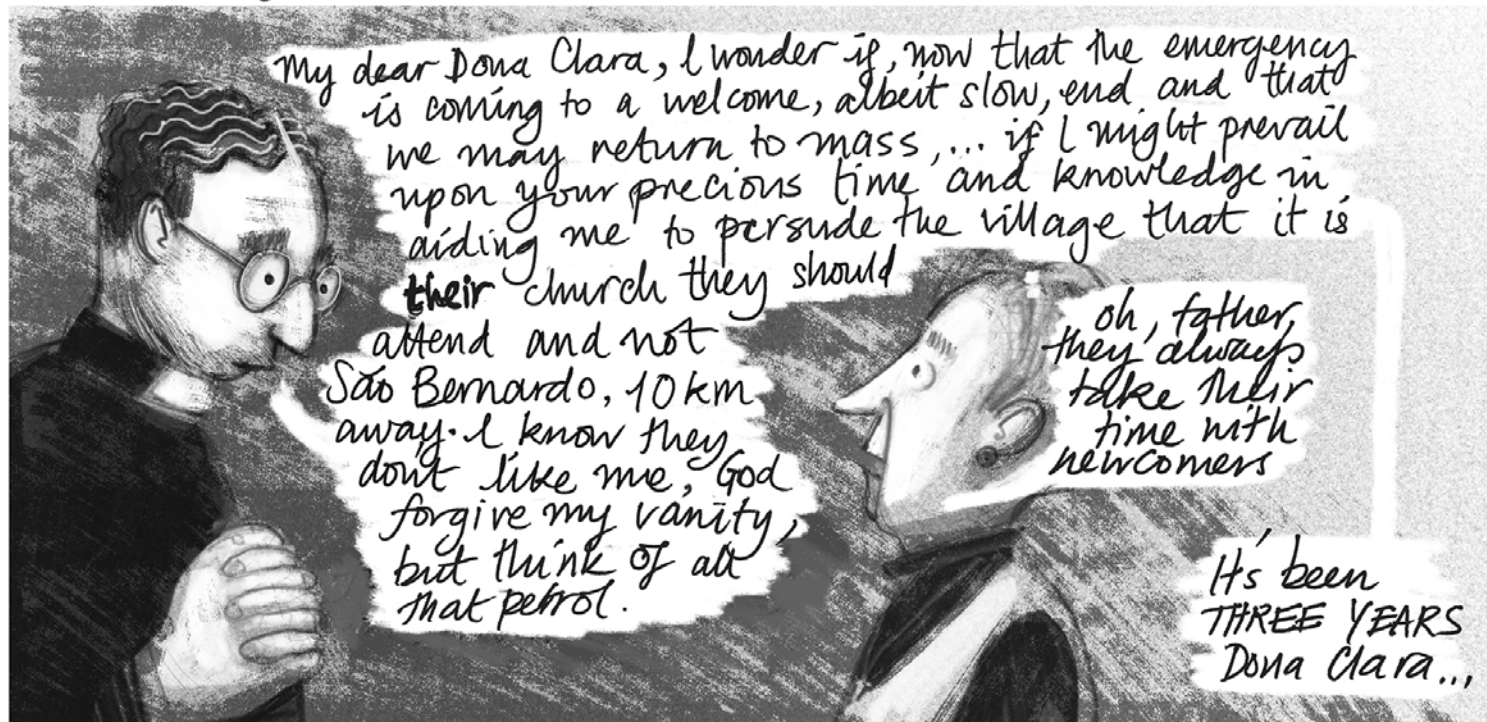


The Village - PART TWO









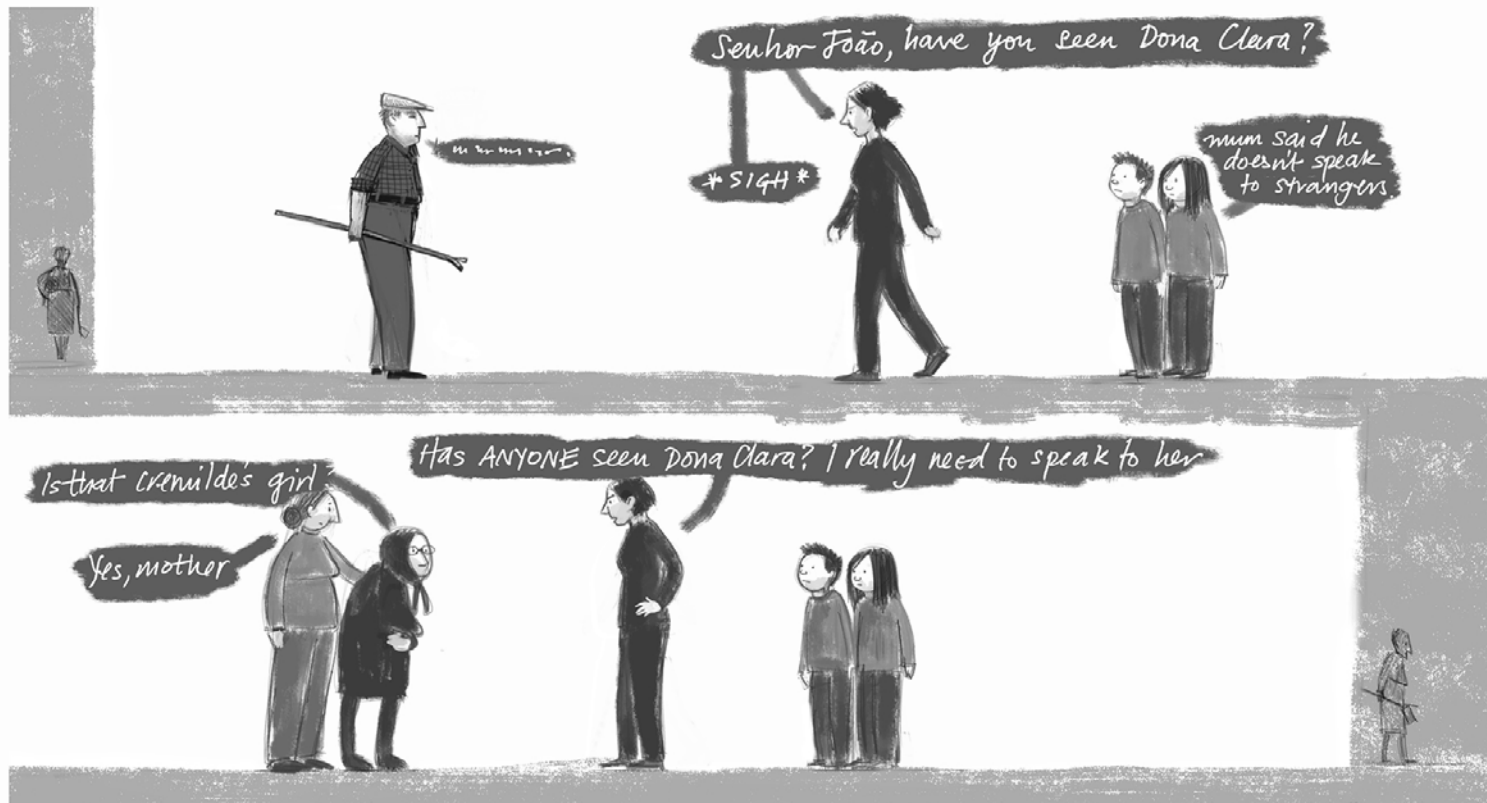
Who was that?

died that day.



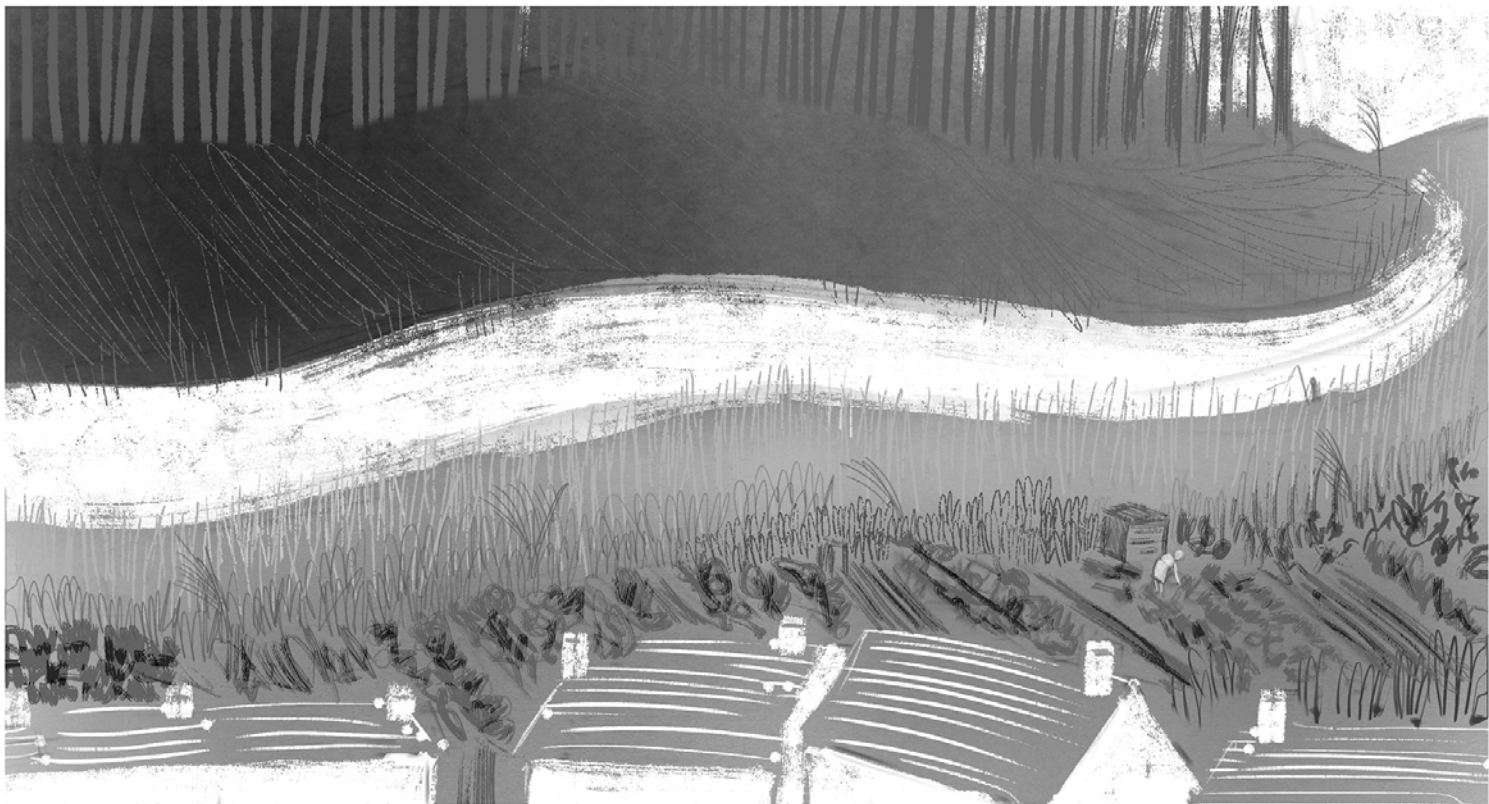


hello father, I'm Ana, I used to live here.
